He was a member of the National Guard from 1965 to 1971. He started his own carpentry business and ran that for 40 years. Lowell enjoyed working with wood and shingling "the higher the house or steeper the roof, the better." He enjoyed going to household sales, traveling, hunting and fishing. He married Lauraline Cohrs July 8, 1962, at St. John's Lutheran Church, Pierce. She passed away Feb. 21, 1976. He married Elayne Born Feb. 24, 1991, at Grace Lutheran Church, Neligh. He was a voting member, trustee and on the financial board of St. John's Lutheran Church, Pierce, and a member of the Pierce Jaycees. Survivors are wife Elayne Zellmer of Neligh; son Ty and wife Sally Zellmer of Pierce; grandchildren Trevor and Shawn Zellmer of Pierce; stepchildren Roechelle and husband Kevin Reuss of Neligh, Kevin and wife Susan Born of Prince

George, Va.; six stepgrandchildren and four step great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by parents Herb and Irene, and wife Lauraline passed away Feb. 21, 1976.
