Lucille attended Plainview High School before helping out on the family farm. On May 30, 1963 she married the love of her life, Dale Kieckhafer in Omaha, NE. To this union two children were born, Glen and Nancy.

Lucille was a housewife and a farm wife, always wanting to help Dale on her little tractor she named "Betsy". Her and Dale also owned and operated the Plains Motel. Lucille loved watching the Yankees play ball, she was a very good sewer, loved canning, and was an excellent baker, baking her famous pumpkin and rhubarb pies. Dale and Lucille traveled a lot, including trips to Canada, Germany, but their favorite place to travel was Branson, MO. The two of them farmed for 35 years before moving to Norfolk in 1996. They officially retired and moved to the Norfolk Veterans Home on September 1, 2017.

She is survived by her husband Dale Kieckhafer, son Glen Kieckhafer of Omaha, NE, and daughter Nancy (Mike) Mattson of Wisner, NE, grandchildren: Trenton Kieckhafer, Carlee Kieckhafer, Brody Mattson, Bryce Mattson, and Zander Walter, and one great grandson Oliver Kieckhafer.
