Smith on June 12, 1955, at Methodist Church in Beaver Crossing. After marriage, Frank and Luella lived in Columbus. They operated a sewing machine business. They then moved to Norfolk and continued the sewing business and also operated a beekeeper business. Luella and Frank would travel to Mexico and buy plaster that they would bring back to the states to sell. They also operated Cottonwood Lumber Mill north of Norfolk. They retired from the mill in June 2014. Luella loved gardening, baking, traveling and spending their winters in the Arizona foothills of Yuma. She enjoyed trips in the desert. Smith of Norfolk; children Cindy and husband Steve Kurpgeweit of Wisner, Sandra and husband Greg Korth of Norfolk, Barbara and husband Dean Fancher of Pierce, Jay and wife Lori Smith of Norfolk; 11 grandchildren; 4 great-grandchildren and one on the way; two sister in-laws Bonnie Scott of Lincoln, and Deloris Scott of Friend. 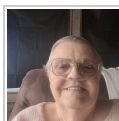
