She was lifetime member of St. John's Lutheran Church of Pierce where she was baptized, confirmed and married. She attended District 80 and St. John's Lutheran schools through the eighth grade. She married Marvin Emil Meyer on Nov. 11, 1952. After her marriage, she worked with her husband at the Corner Bar until her children were born. After her husband suffered from back injuries she again returned to the work force working at the Corner Bar and Steakhouse and later at Schultz's Gambles Store, Rudy's IGA, Donrel's Foodtown, Hometown Market and Farm & Garden

Greenhouse.

She was active in St. John's Lutheran Church ladies aid and fellowship club. She served as a Cub Scout den mother and 4-H leader. She enjoyed morning coffee at the Dairy Sweet and senior center. She became a resident of the Pierce Manor, now known as Premier Estates, in November 2014.
