Mabel married Louie Bockelmann on September 22, 1940 at St. John's Lutheran Church, Norfolk. After marriage, they moved to a farm north of Pierce and farmed there for 19 years. In 1960, they moved to another farm 3 ½ miles northwest of Pierce and farmed and started a business selling and repairing Motorola T.V.'s.

In 1971, Louie and Mabel retired and moved to Norfolk. After Louie's passing on December 7, 1987, Mabel later sold her house in 2010 and moved to the Meadows and then later Heritage of Bel Air where she passed away to her heavenly home.

Mabel enjoyed working with her husband and working outside keeping their

yard beautiful. They enjoyed traveling and fishing, family gatherings, and especially for the Corn Husker football games. Her favorites were reading and shopping. Church was an important aspect in her life; she was very active helping with funerals when needed and was strong in her faith.
