“ Dear Family,

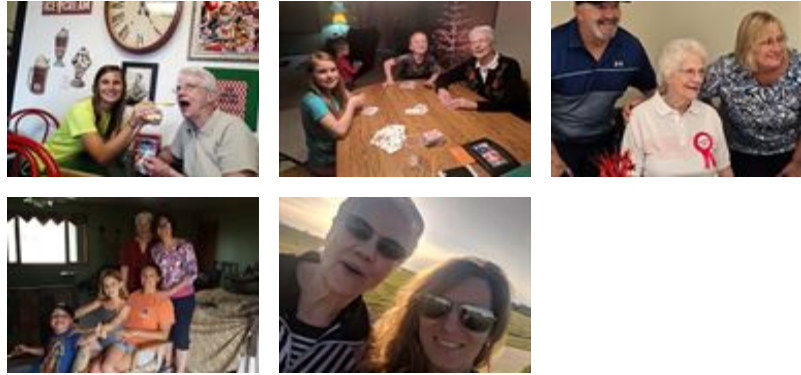
