



Mahlon R. "Rudy" Nuttelmann

January 19, 1929 - July 19, 2017

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Mahlon R. "Rudy" Nuttelmann, 88, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Tuesday, July 25, 2017 at the Trinity Episcopal Church in Norfolk with Rev. Peter Jarkswain officiating. Interment will be in the Prospect Hill Cemetery, Norfolk. Visitation will be held 4:00-7:00 p.m., Monday, at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Military rites will be conducted by the American Legion Post 16, V.F.W. Post 1644, both of Norfolk, and the United States Army Honors Guard. Rudy died Wednesday, July 19, 2017 at the St. Joseph's Care Center in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Mahlon R. "Rudy" Nuttelmann was born Jan. 19, 1929, in O'Neill, the son of Mahlon and Suzanna (Walmsley) Nuttleman Sr. Rudy attended school in Norfolk before entering the U.S Army.

He served from Feb. 3, 1946, to Dec. 21, 1949, following World War II, as well as from Sept. 26, 1950, to Oct. 29, 1951, during the Korean War. He was a sergeant at the time of his discharge.

He married Bobby Blevins on March 3, 1962, in Yankton. Mahlon and Bobby lived in Norfolk. Mahlon worked at Nash Finch, Vulcraft, Shaw Trucking, Lindsey Manufacturing and Mid-Continent Bottling. Mahlon retired in 1986. Mahlon enjoyed hunting, fishing, traveling and he was also an avid Nebraska Cornhusker and Chicago Cubs fan. He was a member of American Legion Post 16, VFW Post 1644 and Trinity Episcopal Church, all of Norfolk.

Survivors include a daughter, Terri (Daniel) Moss of Lexington; a son, Gary

(Brenda) Nuttelmann of Columbus; a son, Jerry (Chelle) Nuttelmann of Omaha; 10 grandchildren; 18 great-grandchildren; a brother, Doug (Bonnie) Nuttelmann of Norfolk; numerous nieces and nephews; and his longtime companion, Dorothy Ambroz of Norfolk.

He was preceded in death by his spouse, Bobby in 1986; his parents, Mahlon Sr. and Suzanna; and a son, Pete Odey.

Organist will be Deb Wolverton and soloist will be Natalie Garden.
