She attended McLean Public School until 11th grade and then transferred to St. Frances in 1955, graduating in 1956. After graduation she moved to Omaha and was employed at Northwestern Bell in the accounting office for four years. While in Omaha, she played on a women's fast-pitch softball team, where she was the pitcher. Sally married Neil D. Bloomquist on Oct. 1, 1960, at St. Frances Catholic Church in Randolph. They made their home on the family farm near McLean for the past 52 years.
