NORFOLK -- A family only memorial service for Marilyn M. Brockman, 82, of Norfolk will be held on Saturday, November 14, 2020. Marilyn passed away on Sunday, October 11, 2020 at the Heritage of Bel Air Nursing Home in Norfolk after a battle with cancer. Inurnment will be held at the Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Marilyn was born on November 12, 1937 in Stanton County, NE to Otto and Esther (Goetsch) Schlueter. She graduated from Madison High School in 1955, and attended one year at Norfolk Junior College.

Marilyn married Jack Brockman on August 25, 1957 at St. John's Green Garden Church, rural Madison, NE. After marriage, Jack and Marilyn farmed in the Winside area for 51 years. She worked at Our Lady of Lord's Hospital as a Nurses Aide for 3 years. Marilyn also sold Avon for over 20 years. She moved to Norfolk in November of 2008.

Survivors include four children: Brad Brockman of Nashville, TN, Daniel Brockman of Winside, Debra and husband Martin Novak of Springfield, VA, and Julie Brockman of Lincoln; three grandchildren; one great grandchild, one brother Randall (Janet) Schlueter, many nieces, nephews, and cousins.

She was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Winside and the Winside Legion Auxiliary. She was preceded in death by her husband Jack in 2011, parents Otto and Esther, one sister Dorothy, one brother Kenneth.
