



## Marion "Mari" R. Ortmeier

NORFOLK – Funeral services for Marion “Mari” R. Ortmeier, 69, of Norfolk will be held on Saturday, February 21, 2026 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Paul’s Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Interment will follow at the St. Paul’s Lutheran Cemetery. Rev. Paul Hirsch will be officiating the services. Visitation will be held on Friday, February 20, 2026 from 5-7 p.m. at St. Paul’s Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Mari passed away on Friday, February 13, 2026 at the Faith Regional Hospital in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Mari was born on November 4, 1956, in Burke, SD to Wayne and Virginia (Schonebaum) Ahlers. She was raised on a farm near Naper, NE. After she graduated high school, she moved to Norfolk and began working at Dale Electronics. She also worked at Mister Roberts, a men's clothing store & cleaned houses. She met the love of her life, Ed Ortmeier, in college. He proposed in April of 1975 and they later married in May of 1976. She started working at Norfolk Daily News in 1975 as a typist & advertising assistant and for the census bureau in Pierce County. After her first son was born, they moved to Hadar in 1978. While pregnant with her second son, she quit to be a stay-at-home mom. They moved to El Paso, TX in 1982 where she started up “Mari’s Home Daycare” and provided childcare for 15 years. During that time, they added two daughters to their family and she was a top ten Avon sales lady. The family moved back to Nebraska in 1990 to a farm outside Norfolk.

She continued in-home daycare and eventually went back to work at the Norfolk Daily News, where she retired in 2017 as an ad executive.

She was passionate about volunteer work within the church, taught many kids in Sunday school and Vacation Bible School, was a committee member of Go Red for Women, and president of the ladies auxiliary at Nebraska Lutheran. Mari loved life on the farm, raising sheep, donkeys and various animals throughout her life. She was a passionate gardener, an avid reader, and enjoyed sewing and drawing, always drawing up designs for home projects. Music was one of her greatest joys whether she was singing in choir or attending concerts she loved. She enjoyed traveling; the mountains and the beach were among her favorite places. She was an amazing host to family and friends at their farmhouse; she also enjoyed a good game of cards that usually went late into the night. She was the heart of the family—a loving mother, a proud grandmother, and a constant source of encouragement, comfort, and positivity to all who knew her.
