



## Marion Jean Woockman

Jean was born on November 21, 1935 on the family farm, rural Madison County, Nebraska to parents Gustav and Emma (Kruger) Gall. She was baptized and confirmed at Christ Lutheran Church, Norfolk. She attended rural country school at District 11, Madison County, then 7th and 8th grade at Christ Lutheran School, Norfolk. She graduated from Norfolk High School in 1953.

Jean grew up in the Madison County area. She married Jerome C. Woockman on April 18, 1954 at Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk. After marriage, the couple lived in Stanton County where they farmed and operated their dairy for 45 years. Jean worked for 24 years as a Dietary Aide at St. Joseph's Rehabilitation and Care Center in Norfolk. Jean and Jerome were blessed with 3 children, 11 grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren. She enjoyed going to the grandchildren's sporting events, camping with family and friends, playing cards, dominos, square dancing, gardening, making her famous

lemon bars, and eating cherry nut ice cream. Jean thanks God for her faith and her family.

She was a member of Christ Lutheran Church and Servants of the Savior Group at Christ Lutheran Church, Norfolk, Altar Guild, Pricilla's, several bible classes groups, served on election boards for Stanton and Pierce Counties.
