Kenneth and Marjorie enjoyed dancing at Riverside and King's ballroom. She also enjoyed making family meals along with her famous sour cream and raisin pie. She also enjoyed playing her harmonica and taking care of her family. A few of her hobbies included playing marbles and cards. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Norfolk. She was also a part of the

extension club in Norfolk. Survivors include her children, Lawrence (Judy) Henery of Norfolk, Joyce (Rodney) Brand of Foster, Kenneth LeRoy (Carol) Henery of Springfield, S.D.; 14 grandchildren; and numerous great-grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren.
