STANTON -- Marles F. Robins, 73, died Saturday, Dec. 22, 2012, at his home in Stanton. Memorial service will be at St. John's Lutheran Church, Stanton, at 2 p.m. Saturday with private family inurnment at a later date at Stanton City Cemetery under direction of Stonacek Funeral Chapel, Norfolk. He was born Nov. 29, 1939, at Coleridge to Everett and Burnetta (Madsen) Robins. He graduated from Hartington High School in 1957 and Wayne State College in 1962. After college he taught science and math at Battle Creek from 1962 to 1964 and Stanton from 1964 to 1969. He received the Mu Epsilon Nu Henzlic Award for Outstanding Male Teacher in Nebraska in 1967. He married Laurel Belz Dec. 27, 1968, at St. John's Lutheran Church, Stanton. They had two sons, Jonathan and Nicholas. Marles graduated from Fisk University in Nashville, Tenn., with a master's degree in 1970. He taught science and math in Schuyler 1970 to 1976 and David City two years. He worked for Sherwood Medical (Tyco) 20 years and retired in 1999. He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Stanton, elder, was a school board member and served on the Educational Service Unit 8 board. Survivors include wife Laurel Robins of Stanton; two sons, Jonathan and wife Lauren Robins of Elkhorn, Nicholas Robins of Norfolk; two sisters, Janeice Heeckt of High Bridge, N.J., Sharon Christiansen of Bedford, Texas. He was preceded in death by his parents.
