NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Marvin D. Hall, 61, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Tuesday, September 11, 2018 at the First United Methodist Church in Norfolk. Officiate will be Rev. Rai Drake. Graveside service will be 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, at the Pleasant Ridge Cemetery, McCool Junction, NE. Visitation will be held 4:00-7:00 p.m., Monday, at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Marvin passed away Wednesday, September 5, 2018 at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha.

Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements. Marvin D. Hall was born Aug. 22, 1957, in York, the son of Vernon and Charlotte (Rose) Hall. Marv attended grade school in McCool Junction and graduated as valedictorian of McCool Junction High School in 1975. Marv earned an associate degree from York College, then attended the University of Nebraska-Lincoln before transferring to the University of Nebraska Medical Center and completing his bachelor's of science in physical therapy in 1983. After graduation from UNMC in 1983, Marv worked at the Mary Lanning Memorial Hospital in Hastings, then Grape Community Hospital in Hamburg, Iowa. Marvin later worked as director of physical therapy at Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital and Lutheran Community Hospital in Norfolk. Marv helped

establish the physical therapy assistant program at Northeast Community College and served as program director and instructor. Marv then worked as director of rehabilitation services and as a staff physical therapist at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk until he retired in 2016.

He married Theresa Makovicka on April 28, 1979, at York. They later divorced. He served six years in the Nebraska National Guard from 1979 to 1986. He enjoyed gardening, fishing, hunting, reading, Nebraska football and spending time with his family.

Survivors include his children, Terry (Suzy) Hall of Norfolk, Jason Hall of Omaha and Megan (Carter) Wehrer of Omaha; six grandchildren, Madison, Kennedy, Jackson, Scarlett, Sterling and Annabelle; his siblings, Gordon Hall of McCool Junction, Kevin (Pam) Hall of McCool Junction and Deanna Campbell of Omaha.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Vernon and Charlotte.
