NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Marvin L. Jones, 90, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Friday, April 28, 2017 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk, with Pastor Lee Weander officiating. Entombment will be in the Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery Mausoleum, Norfolk. Visitation will be held 3-7:00 p.m., Thursday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Military rites will be conducted by the United States Army Honors Guard, American Legion Post 16, V.F.W. Post 1644, both of Norfolk and the Nebraska American Legion Riders. Marvin passed away Saturday, April 22, 2017 at the Faith Regional Hospital in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

The son of Glen and Sadie (Perfect) Jones was born Oct. 17, 1926, in Norfolk. He attended grade school in Norfolk and graduated from Battle Creek High School. He served in the U.S. Army from Jan. 20, 1945, to Nov. 15, 1946. He served in the South Pacific during World War II, receiving a Bronze Star in a battle in the Philippines.

He married Alberta Miller on Feb. 6, 1951, in Columbus. The couple lived in Norfolk. Marvin was a salesman for H.J. Heinz Co. in grocery sales. He then was property officer and animal control with the Norfolk Police Division for 12 years. Working for the police department was an important part of Marvin's life. Marvin retired from the police department in 1990.

Marvin enjoyed crafts all of his life and he was known as "Marv's Hand Crafted Items." Marvin also enjoyed playing poker, bingo and going to the casino. In

the last few years, he really enjoyed making the poppies for the state of Nebraska.

He was a member of Norfolk VFW Post 1644, membership chairman and commander of VFW and the American Legion Post 16. He was past commander and was All-American commander during his term. He made All America sponsor of Home for Orphans in Cedar Rapids, Mich. He was also a member of the Fraternal Order of Police, VFW and American Legion Color Guard.

Survivors include children Terry and spouse Denise Jones of Norfolk, Marvin Jones of Norfolk, Steven A. and spouse Kerry Jones of Omaha, Cynthia and spouse Leon Chapman of Norfolk, Sandra and spouse Don Booth and family of Albion, Pamela and spouse Mark Kaspar of Norfolk; 10 grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren with two additional ones on the way; and a sister, Hazel, and spouse Stan Blank of Stanton.

He was preceded in death by spouse Alberta Jones in 2014; parents Glen and Sadie; twin sons, Timothy and Thomas in infancy; brothers Melvin, Leonard, Willis and Alfred; and a sister, Annabelle Brown.

Organist will be Trudy Dannelly. Pallbearers will be Terry Jones, Marvin Jones, Steven A. Jones, Leon Chapman, Mark Kaspar and Don Booth. 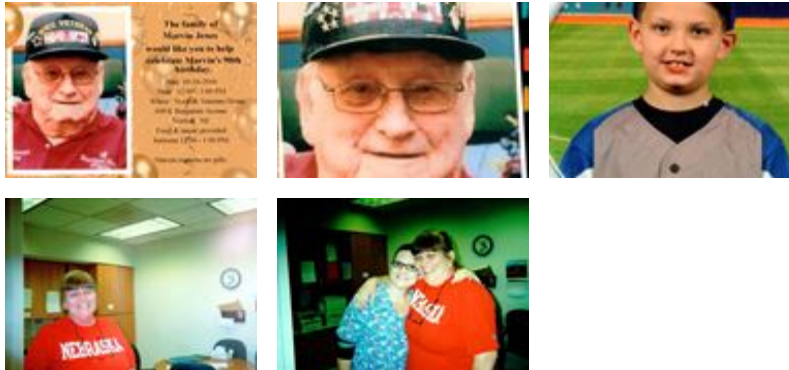
