NORFOLK -- Memorial service for Marvin J. Walmsley, 80, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, August 14, 2021 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Rev. Marvin died Wednesday, November 11, 2020 at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk. The service will be live-streamed on the Stonacek Funeral Chapel Facebook page. Military rites will be conducted by the American Legion Post #16, V.F.W. Post #1644, and United States Army Honor Guard. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk in charge of the arrangements.

They moved from Stanton to Norfolk in 2018. Marvin enjoyed bowling, dancing, darts, shuffle board and playing cards. Marvin was a member of the American Legion Post 72, life member of V.F.W. Post 1644, Norfolk, NE.

Survivors include wife Karen Walmsley of Norfolk, stepdaughter Michelle Koster of Mankato, MN, brother Dwight (Linda) Walmsley of Cullman, AL, sisters Lois Walmsley of Norfolk, Nancy (Ronald) Norris of Plainview, Wanda (Neil) McClary of Meadow Grove, and many nieces, nephews, and cousins.
