NORFOLK — Mary Ann F. Harmeier, 90, of Norfolk died Wednesday, April 23, 2014, at Golden Living Center. Services will be at 10 a.m. Monday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel, Norfolk, with visitation 5-8 p.m. Sunday and the Rev. Terry Buol officiating. Burial will be in Elmwood Cemetery, Carroll.

Mary Ann F. Harmeier was born Sept. 5, 1923, to John and Anna B. (Lang) Stukel in rural Hartington. She graduated from Hartington Cedar Catholic High School in 1940. She married Harold Harmeier in 1942. After marriage, Mary Ann and Harold moved to California and lived in Orange County. They worked in the aviation industry on the assembly line throughout the war. Mary Ann stopped working there in 1949. In 1958 they moved back to Carroll. Harold was a mechanic and carpenter and worked for the village of Carroll. He passed away in 1983. Mary Ann moved to the Odd Fellow Rebekah Lodge. She later married Erwin, and they lived in Norfolk. She was a past member of the Methodist Church at Carroll.

Survivors include son Dennis and wife JoAnn Harmeier of Norfolk, daughter Beverley Asan of Minneapolis, Minn., grandsons Matthew, Scott and Curtis and five great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by both husbands, her parents and three brothers, Gilbert, Virgil and Lavern.
