Maynard Jerome Lee, son of Oscar and Minnie (Kaarstad) Lee was born on the family farm in Boone County on October 14, 1931. He was baptized and confirmed at Immanuel-Zion Church. Maynard attended elementary school at rural District 77 and graduated from Newman Grove High School. Maynard was inducted into the United States Army on December 3, 1952 and honorably discharged on December 2, 1954. On August 21, 1955, he was united in marriage to Doralea Rasmusson at First United Methodist Church in Norfolk. Maynard was engaged in farming his entire life.

Survivors include his wife of 70 years Doralea Lee of Norfolk, five children Renee (Walt) Rosenbaum, Ritchie (Chris) Lee, Kirk (Christy) Lee, Scott (Shelly) Lee, Jim (Cindy) Lee, 13 grandchildren, 20 great-grandchildren, and sister-in-law Geraldine Lee of Newman Grove. He was preceded in death by

his parents Oscar and Minnie Lee, brother Kenneth Lee, and sister Merna and her husband Ken Bowman.
