



## Metha I. Wildermuth

Metha was born into a German family (Koerner) on July 16, 1928 in Freeman, South Dakota to Karl and Sophia (Ulmer) Koerner. Metha was baptized August 5, 1928 and confirmed on March 28, 1942. She had 4 brothers and 3 sisters. After high school, Metha married Devine Wildermuth on December 17, 1946. Devine spent his career in the United States Army, traveling around the world for 26 years. Together they had 3 children (2 sons and 1 daughter). When Devine retired from the military, they moved back to Freeman, South Dakota, where they revived and managed the local V.F.W. Devine passed away in 1993.

Metha moved to Norfolk, NE to be closer to family. She could often be found watching her grandchildren participate in extracurricular activities, listening to baseball on the radio, or sewing quilts for those she loved. Metha enjoyed gardening, flowers, finding the best in people, and being outgoing.
