PIERCE — Private services for Michael D. Hoctor, 72, will be held at the Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce. Burial will be in St. Joseph's Catholic Cemetery in Pierce. The Rev. Keith Rezac of St. Joseph's Catholic Church will officiate. Military rites will be provided by Tomek-Otto Post 72 of the American Legion in Pierce and the U.S. Air Force Honors Guard. He died Jan. 10, 2014, at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk. Michael D. Hoctor was born Dec. 29, 1941, in San Francisco, Calif., to Calvin and Shirley (Samms) Hoctor. He graduated from Clarmont High School in Belmont, Calif., and had a career as a patrolman and security guard. He also served in the Air Force from Oct. 5, 1959, to Oct. 4, 1965. He married Rita Timmerman on Jan. 7, 1998, at Reno, Nev. After they were married, the couple lived in Reno where he worked as a security guard at a casino. They moved back to Nebraska to Richardson County in 2001, then to Hadar in 2008 and later to Pierce. Michael worked in security at Nucor Steel until retiring in 2010. He enjoyed spending time with his family, fishing, doing model planes, collecting guns, knives and rocks. He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus, both in Pierce.

Survivors include his wife, Rita Hoctor of Pierce, and children Michael Hoctor and Holli Hoctor, also of Pierce. He was preceded in death by his parents, Alan and Shirley, and one sister Sue.
