He was a member of Grace Lutheran Church, Norfolk. Mike is survived by his daughter Emily Rossmeier of Norfolk, former wife Pat Schnieder of Norfolk, mother Geraldine Rossmeier of Norfolk, sister Cindy (Kevin) Flesner of Pierce, and many nieces, nephews, and cousins. He was preceded in death by his father Gerald and brother Steven.
