After they were married, they farmed north of Pierce and Milton also measured land for the A.S.C.S office in Pierce. The couple retired from farming in 1989 when they moved to Pierce. Milton and JoAnn did a lot of traveling around the United States. They wintered in Mission, Texas for many years. They celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary July of 2011. Milton enjoyed family times together along with many camping outings, fishing trips, and playing cards. He had a great sense of humor and always enjoyed talking to people. He delivered church service recordings to the shut-ins for many years. Milton is a member of Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce. He served on many church boards and the country school board of education. He has been a resident of Pierce Manor since May of 2010. He is survived by his wife JoAnn Hansen of Pierce; Two daughters: Susan and husband Jerry Richling of Pierce; Sandy and husband Randall Silhacek of Pierce; Five granddaughters and four great-grandchildren.
