NORFOLK -- Myrna E. Raasch, 91, of Denver, Colo., formerly of Norfolk, died Saturday, Dec. 31, 2011, at St. Anthony's Hospital in Lakewood, Colo. Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, with visitation starting at 9 a.m., at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk and burial in St. Paul's Lutheran Cemetery. The Rev. Rodney Rixe will officiate. Myrna Esther Raasch was born Sept. 15, 1920, at Norfolk to Darius and Clara (Henkel) Raasch. She was baptized in September 1920 and confirmed 1933 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Norfolk. She attended District 3 and St. Paul's Parochial School, Norfolk. Myrna graduated from Norfolk Senior High in 1937 and then from Norfolk College of Business in 1939. She also attended Lamont School of Music at the University of Denver, Colo. After college graduation Myrna went to Washington, D.C., and was an administrative secretary for the federal government until Dec. 9, 1940. Over the years, she transferred to Denver, San Francisco and then back to Denver. Myrna retired from government work at Denver in 1980. After retirement she worked as a part-time secretary. In 2003, she started working at the regional transportation district in Denver. She was a member of Zion Evangelical Lutheran, Denver. Survivors include two brothers, Norman and wife Virginia Raasch of Norfolk, Virgil and wife Esther Raasch of Prescott, Ariz.; one niece, Pauline and husband Michael Rose of Mankato, Minn.; two great-nephews, Zach and Benjamin Rose, both of Minnesota. She was preceded in death by parents. Organist will be Mrs. Rogene Moritz with congregational hymns "I Know That My Redeemer Lives," "Abide With Me,"
