NORFOLK – Funeral service for Myrna L. Wulf, 91, of Norfolk, will be held at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, April 23, 2026 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Visitation will be 4:00-7:00 p.m., on Wednesday, April 22 at Stonacek Funeral Chapel. Myrna passed away on Thursday, April 16, 2026 at the Stanton Health Center. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Myrna was born on July 6, 1934 in Clearwater, Nebraska to Roy and Eleanor (Applebee) Tubbs. She attended grade school in Clearwater and Clearwater High School. Myrna moved to Norfolk with her sister and worked at Hested's Department Store. While working at Hested's, Myrna met Arlo Wulf and they were later married on December 12, 1954 at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. After marriage, they worked on a farm outside of Pierce. They later moved to Norfolk. Myrna and Arlo were blessed with three children: Cindy, Matt, and Debbie. The family move to Wakefield and operated Morgan Dairy. They returned to Norfolk and Myrna worked at Wells Dental Lab, Singer Sewing, and Sunset Plaza Mall.

Myrna later received her GED and went to school at St. Joseph's Beauty School. In 1973, she received her license for Cosmetology and worked many years at Franc's Beauty Salon and J.C. Penny Beauty Salon. After her

retirement she worked for Norfolk Public Schools in the kitchens, and substituted at grade school in the kitchen. Myrna was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Norfolk.

Myrna loved her family and always enjoyed when all of them were at her house for the holidays or just to stop by. She was always the last to sit down at a meal and the first to get up if you needed anything. Myrna enjoyed fishing, camping, sewing, crafting, and painting landscapes of the farm where Arlo grew up. She began China painting and many of her pieces went to the State Fair where she received a lot of ribbons on them. Her greatest joy was her kids, grandkids, and great-grandkids. Myrna was always there for each of them and helped anyway she could. Arlo and Myrna were members of the Good Time Coffee Group. They often volunteered at the Veterans Home and Meals on Wheels through their church.

Survivors include her daughter Cindy Rice of Neligh, daughter Deborah (Dave) Schramm of Norfolk, son Matt Wulf of Norfolk, 7 grandchildren, numerous great-grandchildren, sister Eleanor Lee of Stockton, MO, and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband Arlo Wulf in 2011, daughter-in-law Mary Wulf, son-in-law Mike Rice, siblings Lettie Krugman, Oral Tubbs, Nellie Petersen, Marie Derrick, Ralph Tubbs, 2 brothers in infancy Harry Tubbs and Robert Tubbs, 4 nephews, and 3 nieces.

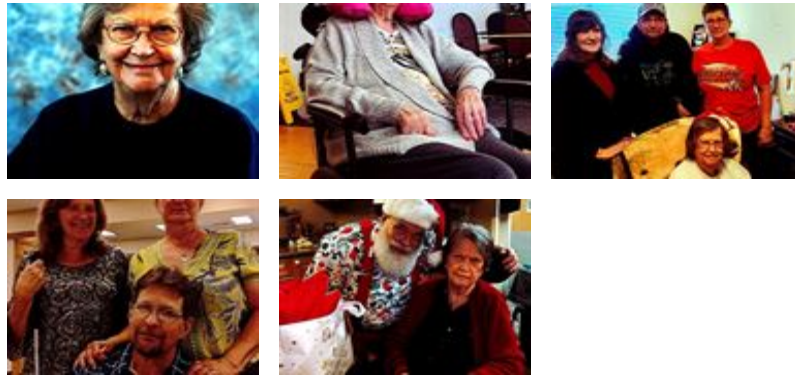
