



Naoma R. "Poots" Schulz

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Naoma R. "Poots" Schulz, 86, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, July 6, 2019 at Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk with Reverend Frank Brink officiating the service. Burial will take place at Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery in Norfolk. Visitation will be held from 4:00 - 7:00 p.m., Friday, at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Naoma died Saturday, June 29, 2019 at the Lakeside Hospital in Omaha. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

The daughter of Oscar and Lillie (Herman) Stueckrath was born Aug. 29, 1932, at McLean. She was baptized on Dec. 4, 1932, and confirmed on June 8, 1947, both at St. John's Lutheran Church in Randolph.

She attended McLean Public School from first through 12th grade, and she graduated in May of 1950. She then graduated from Norfolk Business College and attended Northeast Technical Community College, taking various technology courses.

After college, Naoma began working for French's Photos; followed by a secretarial position at Securities Acceptance Corporation until 1956 when she was married and became a farmwife and homemaker.

She married Donral Schulz on Oct. 7, 1956, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Randolph.

Naoma was a 4-H mentor with the Happy Days 4-H group in Hadar for 20 years. In 1975, she began work as a secretary at Trinity Episcopal Church in Norfolk until retiring in 2004. She has remained active volunteering at Christ

Lutheran Church in Norfolk and also for the VFW Auxiliary Post 1644 of Norfolk. She was a hardworking, loving person known for her humorous personality and big heart.

She was a member of Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk and a lifetime member of the VFW Auxiliary Post 1644.

Survivors include her spouse, Donral Schulz of Norfolk; her daughters, Lynette (Rod) Turner of Omaha and Donette (Scott) Elston of Lincoln; her grandchildren, Matt (Ashley) Turner of Omaha and Katie (Alex) Palmquist of Omaha; her great-grandchildren, Noah, Liam and Jaxon Turner, Braxton and Ryker Palmquist, all of Omaha, sister Eileen "Fuzz" (Dennis) Kucera of Bellwood, NE, and brother Marvin (Deb) Stueckrath of Norfolk.
