Norma passed away on Sunday, March 20, at Osmond General Hospital. Norma was born November 21, 1924, at her grandmother's home in McLean, Nebraska to Edward "E.J." and Edna Mae (Allen) Huey. She was baptized at the Presbyterian Church in Osmond. Norma began 1st grade at age 4 in Osmond. She graduated from Osmond High School with the class of 1941. Norma took classes at Wayne State College. She was active in the family business, Huey Motor Company, for 12 years.

On February 4, 1951, Norma married Elmer "Bud" Schuettler at the Presbyterian Church in Osmond. Norma later became a confirmed member of Immanuel Lutheran Church.

After taking time off to raise her family, she worked in different capacities at the Redwood Inn, Chick's Grocery, Reed Accounting, Osmond Co-op, and

Osmond General Hospital, retiring in 1980. Norma was a 4-H leader for many years, AAL Lamplighter, member and former officer of the VFW and American Legion Auxiliaries, and quilted with the ladies at church. She enjoyed sewing, playing the piano, and was a vocal soloist at many weddings, funerals, and church services throughout her life. Norma will always be remembered by her family and close friends for her caring, loving ways. Survivors include children and their spouses, Kevan (Cyndee) of Osmond, Kim (Gene) Krienert of Lincoln, Kay (Gary) Niedfeldt of Stella, Keri (Greg) Schultze and Kent (Debby) Schuettler, both of Osmond, and Kip (Lisa) Schuettler of Columbus; 18 grandchildren; 19 great-grandchildren; sister-in-law Shirley Huey of Sioux Falls.
