HADAR — Services for Norman H. Raabe, 77, of Hadar will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar. The Rev. Nathaniel Winkel will officiate with burial in Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery in Norfolk. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Sunday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. He died Thursday, Aug. 25, 2016, at Mercy Medical Center in Sioux City. Born April 3, 1939, in rural Madison County, he was the son of Harlen and Esther (Pufahl) Raabe. He was baptized on April 23, 1939, and confirmed on May 6, 1951, both at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar. He attended Immanuel Lutheran Parochial School in Hadar before graduating from Norfolk High School in 1956.

He married Betty Jones on June 14, 1959, at the First Presbyterian Church in Norfolk. They lived in Norfolk before moving to the farm north of Hadar in 1965. While farming, Norman was also trucking for Abler Transfer and C.T.C. He later on had his own truck and hauled.

He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar, where he held numerous church offices and Immanuel Lutheran School offices. He also was a member of Hadar Volunteer Fire Department for 25 years.

Survivors are his spouse, Betty Raabe of Hadar; three sons, Randy Raabe of Pierce and friend Rae Stewart of Wayne, Brian (Shelli) Raabe of Norfolk, Curt Raabe of Hadar; two grandchildren, Bethany Raabe of Omaha and Devon Raabe of Norfolk; and one sister, Shirley Oleson of Norfolk.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Harlen and Esther; a son, Bradley;

a brother, Merlin; and a sister, Marlene Abler.
