He died Saturday, Oct. 7, 2017, at Osmond General Hospital in Osmond.

Norris E. Pfanstiel, the son of Herman August and Frieda (Mohr) Pfanstiel was born Dec. 29, 1934, in Wausa. He was baptized Feb. 3, 1935, and confirmed March 21, 1948, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond. He attended Bunker Hill country school in rural Osmond, Immanuel Lutheran parochial school at Osmond and graduated from Osmond High School in 1952. After high school, Norris worked at a meat packing plant in Sioux City. He then went to work for Theisen Construction from 1955 to 1959.

He married Cleo Timmerman on Feb. 10, 1957, at Osmond. After the couple were married, they farmed in the McLean area from 1959 to 2012. They also did custom hay work. They moved to Osmond in 1998.

Norris enjoyed fishing with family and friends, joking around with everyone, going out to eat and making carmel corn. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond.
