PIERCE — Services for Opal Krienke, 95, of Pierce will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at the United Methodist Church in Pierce with burial in Prospect View Cemetery and the Rev. She was married to Theodore H. “Ted “ Krienke on Nov. 21, 1945, at the United Methodist Church, Pierce, by the Rev. Ireland. After they were married they farmed south and west of Pierce. She had been a resident of the Pierce Manor since August 2014. She was a member of the United Methodist Church, Pierce, Rebekah Lodge for many years and the Ladies Aid.
