



## Orlon E. "Bud" Hartwig

June 30, 1927 - March 4, 2018

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Orlon E. "Bud" Hartwig, 90, of Norfolk will be held at 2:00 p.m., Monday, March 12, 2018 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with Pastor Clark Jenkinson officiating. Private burial will be held at the Spring Branch Cemetery, rural Norfolk. Visitation for Bud will begin at 1:00 p.m., prior to the service on Monday.

Military rites will be provided by the United States Army Honors Guard, American Legion Post 16 and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1644, both of Norfolk.

Bud passed away Sunday, March 4, 2018 at his residence in Norfolk.

Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Born June 30, 1927, on a farm near Norfolk, Orlon E. "Bud" Hartwig was the son of Edward and Martha (Neitzke) Hartwig. He was baptized and confirmed at the Peace United Church of Christ in rural Hoskins. He attended School District 11 in Stanton County before graduating from Norfolk Senior High School.

He served in the U.S. Army from Oct. 26, 1945, to June 5, 1946, during the Japan occupation. He then served in the U.S. Army Air Corps from June 6, 1946, to July 20, 1947.

Bud married LaVonne Schultz in 1952 at Grace Lutheran Church in Norfolk. He worked as a rural postal mailman in Norfolk before moving on to California, New Mexico and eventually Florida. While away from Norfolk, Bud owned a motel in New Mexico and Yuma, Arizona with LaVonne. They then went to

Hallandale, Florida where they owned Hartwig apartments for over 20 years. In 1993, Bud retired and finally moved back to Norfolk in 2006 upon the death of his late spouse, LaVonne.

Survivors include his sister, Carol (Bob) Kentfield of Westminster, Colo.; a brother-in-law, Albert Stanock of Anaheim, Calif., sister-in-law Evelyn Kleinsasser, brother-in-law Glen K. Schultz of Florida; and several nieces, nephews, cousins; and good friends, Cheryl and Ken Miller and the Wheeler family.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Edward and Martha; his spouse, LaVonne; two daughters, Pam and Terry; and a son, Bruce.
