



Patricia A. "Pat" Achor

June 25, 1935 - March 27, 2024

NORFOLK -- Graveside inurnment for Patricia A. "Pat" Achor, 88 of Norfolk, will take place at 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, June 26, 2024 at the Omaha National Cemetery, Omaha, NE. Pat died on Wednesday, March 27, 2024 at Heritage of Bel Air Nursing Home in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Pat was born on June 25, 1935 in St. Johnsbury, Vermont, to James M. and Madeline P. (Palmer) Hendry. The family moved to New York, then Indiana, where Pat later met her husband, John, a pilot in the Air Force. They were married in 1955 and had three children, Kathy, Karen, and Mark. Pat and John lived in Arizona, Massachusetts, Washington, Alaska, Florida, Nebraska, Texas, and Arkansas. Pat was a homemaker, artist, and cake decorator extraordinaire. She worked as an office manager, a real estate agent, and at a child abuse prevention center. She volunteered at an animal shelter and the library, and was an activist for women's rights. After retiring, Pat, an avid reader, enjoyed devouring several books a week and served as a manuscript reader for a small publisher of mystery novels. In their 80s, Pat and John returned to Nebraska. Pat stayed busy reading, proofreading her retirement community's newsletters, joining a group for those dealing with macular degeneration, and spoiling her granddaughters as often as she could. Pat and John were married for 68 years before John's passing in September of 2023. When asked what was most important to her, Pat always answered, "My

family.” She will be deeply missed.

Survivors include daughters Kathy (Jim) Nicely of Edmond, Oklahoma, and Karen (Tom) Edmisten of Norfolk, Nebraska, son Mark Achor of Clovis, New Mexico, and grandchildren, Emily Edmisten, Lizzy (Zech) Blackburn, Kate Edmisten, Mirelly Armendariz, and Natalie Achor. Pat was preceded in death by her parents (James and Madeline), and husband, John Achor.
