He died Saturday, Feb. 26, 2011, at Pierce Manor. He was born Oct. 20, 1918, at Bedford, Iowa, to Glenn and Cassie (Miller) Snyder. He graduated from Bedford, Iowa, High School in 1937. After high school, Paul moved to Omaha and married Mary Lou Pendergast Nov. 26, 1939, at Plainview. Paul entered the Army during World War II and served in the Philippines from 1943 to 1945. Later he would move to the Washington, D.C., area to work for the federal government in the ASA and NSA. Paul retired to Louisa, Va., in 1972. He returned to Pierce in 1993, where he enjoyed various hobbies. Paul and Mary Lou attended motor coach rallies and traveled in their motor coach to Florida and Texas. Survivors include wife Mary Lou of Pierce; two sons, Jim and Becky Snyder of Las Vegas, Nev., and Eugene and wife Diane Snyder of Camden, S.C.; three grandchildren; two great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents.
