RANDOLPH — Peggy Jean Weyhrich, 88, of Norfolk died Wednesday, April 1, 2015, at Osmond General Hospital. A celebration of life service will be at 1:30 p.m. Friday at St. John's Lutheran Church, Randolph, with private inurnment at Rose Hill Cemetery, McLean. Visitation will be 6-8 p.m. Thursday at the church. The Rev. Derrick Fallon will officiate. Arrangements are by Stonacek Funeral Chapel of Osmond. She was born April 17, 1926, at rural McLean to Edward and Anna Neumeier (Wecker). She was baptized July 18, 1926, St. John's Lutheran Church, Randolph, and confirmed April 6, 1941, at Hope Lutheran Church, McLean. She graduated from McLean High School on May 12, 1944. She married Alvin G. "Curly" Weyhrich on Jan. 21, 1945, at St. John's Lutheran Church, Randolph. After Peggy and Alvin were married a short time, he was inducted into the Army. After his honorable discharge in 1946, they began farming in the Osmond area. They lived there until September of 1987, when they semi-retired and moved into Randolph. They spent their winters in Sun City Center, Fla., from 1991 to 2002. She enjoyed gardening, church functions and spending time with her family. She was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Randolph, past Ladies Aid member, Dorcas Circle and taught Sunday school many years. Survivors include three daughters, DeLana and husband Rick Westbrook of Rock Hill, S.C., Pamela Van Auker of Jacksonville Beach, Fla., Jacquelyn and husband Mike Knight of Falls Church, Va.; two sons, Kirk and wife Julene Weyhrich of Osmond, Todd and wife Jodi Weyhrich of Pennington, N.J.; seven

grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren; one sister, Arlene Dinkle of LaVerne, Calif.; one brother, Orvin and wife Julia Neumeier of Aurora, Colo.
