



## Philip "Phil" D. Steinkamp

NORFOLK – Funeral service for Philip D. “Phil” Steinkamp, 68, of Pierce, will be held at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, April 29, 2026 at the First Christian Church in Norfolk. Phil was born on October 18, 1957 in Belleville, Illinois to Leroy and Nora (Joellenbeck) Steinkamp. He attended grade school at Okawville grade school in Okawville, Illinois. He graduated from Okawville High School and then attended Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, Illinois. Phil worked for Habit for Humanity then later attended Colorado State University earning his Masters Degree of International Agriculture in 1998. He married Katherine Falcone on December 6, 1997 at Summit Lake Community Church in Mancos, CO. After marriage the family lived in Neligh, they then moved to Norfolk in 2006, and later Pierce in 2023. Phil worked as an agronomist doing soil testing for various organizations throughout Nebraska. He later worked for

Pillen Family Farms for 10 years until he retired. Philip enjoyed fishing, camping, hunting and collecting arrowheads.

Survivors include his wife Kathy Steinkamp of Pierce, children Thomas (Marie) Steinkamp of Littleton, CO, Lindsay (Tyler) Jacot of Norfolk, 5 grandchildren Raedan Jacot, Faythe Jacot, Hope Jacot, Emilia Steinkamp, Benjamin Steinkamp, mother Nora Seevers, “adopted daughter” Mimi Rattana Chockduangdee of Thailand, and many other adopted children. 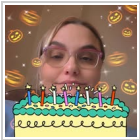
