NORFOLK — Phyllis M. Kudera, 86, of Hoskins died Wednesday, Oct. 1, 2014, at Heritage of Bel Air. Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with visitation 5-7 p.m. Friday. The Rev. Mark Reichert will officiate. Burial will be at Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery. She was born Feb. 24, 1928, in Pierce County to Fred and Martha (Lienemann) Bargstadt. She was baptized Feb. 24, 1928, at Zion East Lutheran Church, rural Hoskins, by Pastor E.H. Boelling and confirmed there June 14, 1942, also by Pastor E.H. Boelling. She attended Hoskins school until the 10th grade. Phyllis married John J. Kudera on May 24, 1944. She was a housewife until 1960 when she began working at Roehns and was there for seven years. In 1967, Phyllis and John moved to Greely, Colo., where they lived for 23 years. While in Colorado, Phyllis worked for the Kodak Company for 15 years before retiring in May 1990. They returned to Nebraska in May 1990 and lived at Boulevard Village until Phyllis entered Heritage of Bel Air Nursing Home in February 2013. She was a member of Pierce Legion Auxiliary. Survivors are two daughters, Patricia and husband Harold Brudigan of Hoskins, Barbara and husband Larry Colehour of Central City, Iowa; two sons, Terry and wife Sue Kudera of Lapeer, Mich., Barry and wife Kathy Kudera of Oceanside, Calif.; eight grandchildren, eight great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews and cousins. She was preceded in death by parents Fred and Martha; husband John who passed away March 31, 2000; one brother, Roy Bargstadt; and one sister, Arlene Shelton. Music will be by organist
