



## Randall L. "Randy" Brumels

September 13, 1932 - February 4, 2018

NORFOLK -- Memorial service for Randall L. "Randy" Brumels, 85, of Atkinson, formerly of Norfolk will be held at 11:00 a.m., Saturday, February 10, 2018 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with Rev. Terry Buol officiating. Inurnment will be a private family service at a later date. Visitation will begin at 9:00 am, prior to the service also on Saturday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel. Military rites will be conducted by American Legion Post 16 and V.F.W. Post 1644 both of Norfolk, the U.S. Army Honors Guard, and the Nebraska Legion Riders.

Randy died Sunday, February 4, 2018 at his residence in Atkinson, NE.

Randall L. "Randy" Brumels was born to Ben and Dorothea (Draesen) Brumels on Sept. 13, 1932, on the family farm in rural Hoskins. He attended Hoskins Public School through the 10th grade. He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War from Jan. 21, 1953, to Jan. 19, 1955.

He married Karen Salmen on June 20, 1963, in Fairfax, S.D. They later divorced.

Randall lived in Norfolk and worked for Harding Glass and Barber Glass.

Randall then began his own business — Randy's Glass — in 1969 and ran it until retiring in 1992.

He married Lora "Ruth" Carr on May 30, 1996, at Columbus.

On Oct. 12, 2016, Randy and Lora "Ruth" moved to Atkinson. Randy enjoyed dancing, playing pool, shuffleboard, dancing and had his own band "Randy

Brumels Orchestra.”

Survivors are his spouse, Ruth Brumels of Atkinson; a daughter, Sandra (Ronald) Tappan of Elm Creek; his stepchildren, Orlan Braun of Atkinson, Elaine Clemens of Atkinson and Daryl Braun of Atkinson; his grandchildren, Cheryl Dalton, Michaela Terry, Jeffery (Amy) Tappan, Justin Terry, Nichole (Kabir) Poland, Jerry Brumels, Troy Brumels, Nickolas Brumels; six great-grandchildren; many stepgrandchildren and stepgreat-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Ben and Dorothea; three brothers, Duane, Donald and Gerald; and a son, Jerry.
