Randy worked with Lowell Zellmer Construction over the years and farmed west of Pierce with his father, Reuben, and brothers Gale and Rick, and later on, with his daughter, Rebecca, and son-in-law Jimmy. Randy retired from farming in 2016.

Randy enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren and going to his nieces and nephews sporting events. Randy enjoyed fishing, classic car shows and going to dances.

He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce.
