NORFOLK — Services for Raymond L. "Bud" Walker, 92, of Norfolk will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Peace United Church of Christ, Norfolk, with burial in Spring Branch Cemetery.

Survivors include wife Frances Walker of Norfolk; children Mark and wife Vicki Walker of Norfolk, Linda and husband Brad Bartlett of Omaha, Neal and wife Debra Walker of Hoskins; seven grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; two brothers, Wesley and wife Joan Walker of Prescott Valley, Ariz., Don and wife Marlene Walker of Norfolk; one sister, Lillian Heckman of Hadar.

He was preceded in death by parents; one son (Duane 1969); two brothers, Ben and Marvin; two sisters, Florence and Marian.
