NORFOLK – Funeral Service for Richard “Dick” L. Jenson, 86 of Norfolk, will be held on Tuesday, September 16, 2025 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Johns Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Visitation will be held on Monday, September 15, 2025 from 4-7 p.m. at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Dick passed away on Thursday, September 11, 2025 at Faith Regional Hospital in Norfolk. Richard “Dick” L. Jenson was born April 22, 1939 in Newman Grove, NE to Kenneth and Margaret “Dolly” (Flood) Jenson. He was confirmed at Zion Lutheran Church in Newman Grove. He graduated from Newman Grove High School in 1958. He farmed with his father and worked for the Gas Company, transferring to Norfolk, Nebraska as a customer serviceman in 1967, retiring in 2005 with 47 years of service. He served in the U.S. Army Reserve for 6 years.

He married Mary Ann Hestekind at Zion Lutheran Church in Newman Grove, NE on November 14, 1964. To this union one son, Michael, was born on November 5, 1974. He was an active member of St. John’s Lutheran Church in Norfolk, NE. He was also a member of the Norfolk Antique Auto Club. He and Mary Ann enjoyed traveling, attending Antique Auto Club Tours, restoring

old cars, and tinkering.

He is survived by his wife Mary Ann, and one son, Michael L. Jenson, 2 granddaughters, Danelle and Madison of Bellwood, NE, 3 great grandchildren, Kingslee, Oliver, and Ellena. Sister Nancy Albracht and husband Wayne of Madison, NE, sister-in-law Jeanie Jenson of Norfolk, NE, brother-in-law's Bob Hestekind of Montana, and Jerry (Judy) Hestekind of Elgin, NE, along with several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

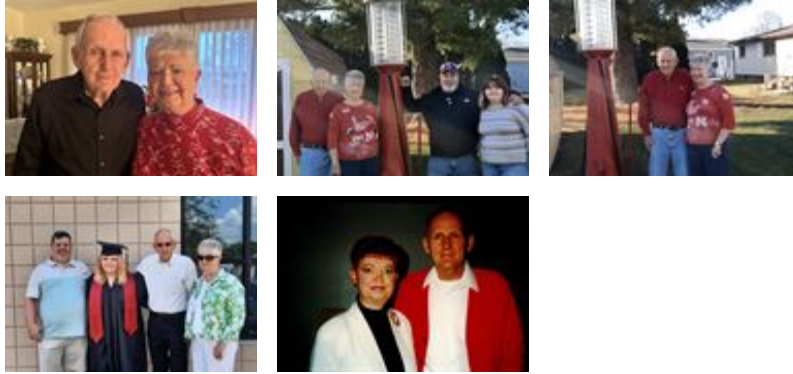
