Dick attended Brunswick High School and graduated with the class of 1952. Dick grew up with brothers, Raymond and Robert and sisters, Rozella and Roxanne. He lived with his beloved grandparents, Wilhelm Johann and Sophia (Priest) Haase during high school. On November 13, 1952 Dick was inducted into the United States Marine Corps where he served as a Clerk for three years, during the Korean War. He held the rank of Sergeant when he received his Honorable Discharge on September 1, 1955. Dick attended Southern State Teachers College in Springfield, SD where he graduated with a B.S. in Education in 1958. Dick graduated from University of South Dakota where he obtained his Master's Degree in Physical Education and a Master's Degree in Administration. Dick met Arlene Schlender in Minot, ND and they married August 17, 1963.

The couple had three children: Robin, Todd and Beth. Dick also has two sons, Rick and Wes Haase. On August 17, 2013, Dick and Arlene celebrated 50 years of marriage with the renewal of their wedding vows at Holy Cross Lutheran Church in Anita, IA.

Dick was a Teacher, Coach and Counselor for many years. He taught in schools in Alaska, Minnesota, Washington and Nebraska. Dick had a love for "God's Country" as he would call Alaska. He enjoyed fishing, hunting and sports. Arlene and Dick traveled across the country and enjoyed visiting friends from every state! They lived in many communities and made a lot of friends. Arlene passed away April 9, 2014 and Dick was lost without her. He joined her in heaven on January 28, 2015.

Dick was a former member of Holy Cross Lutheran Church of Anita, IA and is a member of Immanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church of Lincoln, NE.
