NORFOLK -- Memorial service for Richard W. "Dick" Schlecht, 74, of Norfolk will be held at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, January 3, 2024 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Dick was born on December 13, 1949 in Norfolk, Nebraska to Wayne and Maye (Bathke) Schlecht. He graduated from Norfolk Senior High in 1968. Dick entered the United States Marine Reserves from September 25, 1970 till August 13, 1976. Dick married Pat Schiermeier on September 5, 1970 in Stanton. Dick went to trade school and worked in Omaha until moving back to Norfolk in 1975. Dick worked at Geary Electric until following his father's footsteps and joining the Norfolk Fire Dept in April 1976. Dick retired at the rank of Inspector from Norfolk Fire Dept. in May 2010 after 34 years of service.

Dick worked as a licensed electrician for Model Electric for 33 years from 1990 to 2023. Dick received his Fire Science Degree from Northeast Community College in 1990. Dick enjoyed camping, fishing and hunting, playing cards, and loved spending time with family and friends. Dick was an avid fan of Husker football and volleyball. Dick and Pat enjoyed traveling when they could.

Survivors include his wife Pat Schlecht, son Neil Schlecht and his daughter Emily Schlecht, son Jason Schlecht and his daughter Elizabeth Schlecht, sister Sharon Mattison, brother-in-law Merle Schiermeier, nephew Sean McKown, nieces Shelley McDonald, Leslie Fortin, many cousins, friends, and coworkers. 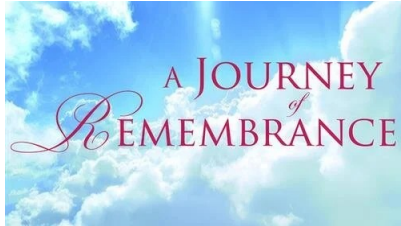
