



Rick G. Vetsch

January 21, 1947 - March 31, 2015

PIERCE — Private memorial services for Rick G. Vetsch, 68, of Pierce will be at a later date under the direction of Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Pierce. He died Tuesday, March 31, 2015, at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk.

The son of Gabriel Edmund and Lola Mae (Crawford) Vetsch was born Jan. 21, 1947, at Hastings. He graduated from Fairbury High School and served in the U.S. Navy from June 9, 1966, to July 16, 1971 as a photographic interpreter. After serving in the U.S. Navy, Rick was a policeman and then a deputy sheriff in York. He was later a regular fix-wing pilot for Don Marr Aviation in York and a spray pilot in Neligh for the co-op.

He married Suzanne Williams on Sept. 2, 1967, at Meridian, Miss. Rick and Suzanne later moved to Pierce in 1980, and he was the parts manager for the Norfolk Airport. He also owned Computer Aided Drafting Service, which he drew the City of Norfolk's maps and surrounding areas.

His pride and joy was his woodworking shop.

Survivors include his wife, Suzanne Vetsch of Pierce and son Vince Vetsch of Norfolk.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Gabriel and Lola, a sister, Rebecca, and a son, Jonathon in November 2006.
