“ *R. J. FARQUHARSON received the BSME in 1945 and the MSME in 1951 from Stevens Institute of Technology. During the time he was attending evening graduate school, he was employed by Raybestos-Manhattan Inc. and U.S. Rubber Company as a design and development engineer responsible for test equipment design and for product design specializing in conveyor belts. He joined RCA in 1952, and served as a mechanical design engineer. He was responsible for the packaging of many military equipments ranging in size from the ultra portable to the large multi rack system; in frequency from low speed digital computer through portable transmitter- receivers and including high frequency single sideband and television equipments. He was assigned to a project management office as mechanical coordinator, and as the project engineer for the digital data equipment. Mr. Farquharson was a professional engineer licensed in New Jersey, a member of the Franklin Institute, and the IEEE.*
