



Robert F."Bob" Tiedgen

November 4, 1928 - October 18, 2015

NORFOLK -- Funeral Services for Robert F. "Bob" Tiedgen, 86, of Norfolk will be held at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 21, 2015 at the Mt. Visitation will be held 4:00-7:00 pm, Tuesday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel, Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements. Bob passed away Sunday, October 18, 2015 at his residence.

Bob was born November 4, 1928 on a farm North of Meadow Grove to Fred and Alma (Ruegge) Tiedgen. He later spent many years near Clearwater before moving to the Tiedgen homestead in 1938, southwest of Battle Creek. He attended Deer Creek Grade School where he rode his horse "Babe" to school with his sister Doreen. Bob graduated from Battle Creek High School in 1945. He married Mary Rouse on February 20, 1950 in Yankton, SD. He was a dedicated farmer all of his life, which he dearly loved to do. He raised cattle, hogs, sheep, and chickens besides his farming. He retired from farming in 2009 due to health reasons.

In 1963 Bob started Auctioneering and has cried many-many auctions. In 1974 he received his Real Estate License. He continued auctioneering and real estate until 2015 when his health prevented him from continuing.

Surviving Bob is his wife of 65 ½ years Mary Tiedgen of Norfolk, children Fred (Dee) Tiedgen of Meadow Grove, Kathy (Russ) Whitmore of Norfolk, Bev Rath

of Battle Creek, Karen Tiedgen of Battle Creek, and Rob Tiedgen of Battle Creek, 19 grandchildren, 35 great-grandchildren, and 2 great-great grandchildren, sister Doreen (Art) Froding of Woodburn, OR, and numerous nephews and nieces.

He was preceded in death by his parents Fred and Alma, sister and brother-in-law Darlene (Dolly) and Irvn Forslund.
