



Roger W. Feddern

January 25, 1944 - January 28, 2017

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Roger W. Feddern, 73 of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Friday, February 3, 2017 at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Norfolk with Rev. Lee Weander and Rev. Ryan Taylor officiating. Interment will be at the New Lutheran Cemetery, Norfolk. Visitation will be held 4:00-7:00 p.m., Thursday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Military rites will be by American Legion Post 16, Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1644, Nebraska American Legion Riders, and the United States Navy.

Roger passed away Saturday, January 28, 2017 at the Norfolk Veterans Home.

Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

The son of Emil R. and Ella M. (Bockelman) Feddern was born Jan. 25, 1944, in Norfolk. He was baptized on Feb. 13, 1944, and confirmed March 30, 1958, both at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. He attended rural school at Pierce, Zion Lutheran Parochial School in Pierce and graduated from Pierce High School in 1962.

During high school, Roger participated in football, track and FFA. He was named in the Top 20 Prepstars for the State of Nebraska in 1961 in football. After graduating from high school, Roger served in the U.S. Navy from June 27, 1962, to Aug. 24, 1966. He was a radio man (E-4), and his greatest memory is his service in the military. He served on the USS Hawkins, the only destroyer off the East Coast that went to Vietnam. His job was coding and decoding messages.

He married Margaret Wiese on Aug. 20, 1967, at the First Presbyterian Church in Norfolk. They lived in Norfolk, where Roger worked for Pettit Plumbing and Heating from 1966 to 1978 and then Roto Rooter from 1978 to 1981. From 1982 to 1988, Roger owned and operated Sewer King. He then worked for Sanitary Improvement District 1 as a maintenance engineer in Woodland Park from 1988 to 2008 and Sanitary Improvement District 3 from 1988 to 2008.

Roger was certified as a grade IV water operator by the State of Nebraska Health and Human Services. He also had his master plumbers license from 1978 to 2006.

Roger really enjoyed the time that he and brother-in-law Bob Wiese delivered medicines, groceries and other needed supplies to the people of the Hurricane Katrina Disaster through the Orphan Grain Train.

Roger enjoyed going to the coffee shops, movies and going on road trips with his family. He also enjoyed hunting, fishing, rock collecting and, most importantly, reading his Bible.

Roger had been a resident at the Norfolk Veterans Home since November 2013.

He was a member of Our Savior Lutheran Church in Norfolk, where he served as a trustee. He was a past member of Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk, where he served on the board of education, as an usher and trustee. He was also a member of the Rock and Mineral Club of Norfolk.

Survivors include his spouse, Margaret Ann Feddern of Norfolk; children Lynette Todd of Omaha, Tammy Feddern of Omaha, Mark (Tina) Feddern of Hoskins, Christie (Ben) Pile of Omaha; eight grandchildren, Tyson, Alyssa, Lydia, Londyn, Taylor, Braden, Gavin and Ashton; a brother, Bob (Edith) Feddern of Norfolk; and a sister, Dianne Holland of Norfolk.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Emil and Ella.

Music will be provided by Jordan Miller and Kevin Becker singing "There Will Be A Day" and "Jesus Loves Me." Congregational hymns will be "Amazing Grace," "My Chains Are Gone," and "If You Were My King."
