He served in the U.S. Air Force from 1984 to 1988, and then moved to Washington State for a short time. He later moved to Delhi. Roger worked for Frito Lay as a fork lift operator. He enjoyed playing his guitar and wrote and recorded music. He enjoyed spending time with his family and friends. Roger loved being outdoors, landscaping in his yard, working out and keeping in shape.
