Roger passed away on Thursday, February 20, 2025 at the Heritage of Bel-Air Nursing Home in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Roger was born on August 29, 1947 to Paul and Virginia (Graf) Young in Randolph, NE. He attended elementary, middle, and high school in Randolph and graduated from Randolph High School in 1965. He went on to further his education at Milford Technical College and graduated in 1967 with a diploma in electrical services. He founded Roger Young Electric, Plumbing, and Heating in 1970 and owned the business for 25 years before going to work for Kelly Electric in Kearney, Nebraska and then Model Electric in Norfolk, Nebraska. On February 20, 1971 he married Donna Graham at St. John's Lutheran Church in Randolph.

Roger was a member of the Pierce Jaycees, the Pierce Chamber of Commerce, and served on the Pierce Volunteer Fire Department. In his spare

time, you could find him out on the lake fishing, tinkering in his shop, working with his model trains, or spending quality time with family. Roger was an amazing father and mentor to his kids. As his children grew up watching him build and repair so many different things, they gained valuable experience and knowledge to help them in everyday life as adults.
