After marriage, Ron and Norma lived here in Norfolk all of their married lives. Ron worked 10 years at Meadow Gold, then started working at Gillette Dairy. He retired in 1992 from Gillette Dairy. Ron enjoyed watching his grandchildren and great-grandchildren's sporting events. He also enjoyed fishing, hunting, gardening, playing cards, camping and watching the Nebraska Cornhuskers. He was a member of Mount Olive Lutheran Church for over 50 years, elder of the church and manager of Mount Olive's softball team.
