NORFOLK — A memorial service will be at a later date for Ronald M. Lyons, 69, of Norfolk under direction of Stonacek Funeral Chapel. He died Sunday, Nov. 23, 2014, at his home. He was born Feb. 23, 1945, at Omaha to Donald Monroe and Doris (Vig) Lyons. He graduated from Norfolk High School in 1963. He was married to Karen Chleboun on May 24, 1966, at Yankton, S.D. Ron served in the U.S. Navy from June 7, 1963, to May 3, 1967, and was stationed in Norfolk, Va. They then moved to Norfolk, living here a short time and then moving to Ainsworth for three years and Long Pine and Wayne. They returned to Norfolk in 1978. Ron worked at the Norfolk Regional Center and then worked in maintenance at the Norfolk Veterans Home. Ron enjoyed flying radio- controlled airplanes and building them, metal detecting and his Vizsla hunting dogs. He was a member of Jehovah's Witnesses Kingdom Hall. Survivors are wife Karen Lyons of Norfolk; three daughters, Lisa and husband Mike Lackas of Racine, Wis., Lori Lyons of Norfolk, Ronee Jo and husband Steve Hart of Norfolk; three grandchildren and one great-grandchild; his mother, Doris Vig of Pilger and stepfather, Lee Vig of Pilger; three sisters, Linda and husband Charles Wiechman of Plano, Texas, Sandy and husband Dave Baumert of Kansas City, Mo., and Stacia Stark of Norfolk; and several nieces and nephews.
