MADISON -- Ronald E. Summers, 72, of Madison died Friday, May 3, 2013, at home. Services will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday at United Methodist Church here with burial in Crown Hill Cemetery and the Rev. Cindi Stewart officiating. Visitation will be 5-7:30 p.m. Tuesday at the church under direction of Stonacek Funeral Chapel. Military rites will be by American Legion Post 35. He was born July 29, 1940, at Page to Leslie and Ethel (Goree) Summers. He graduated from Page High School in 1958. He was married to Shirley Schulz Dec. 13, 1964, at United Methodist Church in Madison. Ronald and his wife Shirley owned and operated the Ponderosa Bar in Madison for 18 years. During that time he also worked at Heritage Homes in Wayne for 25 years. After they sold the Ponderosa Bar, they owned and operated Laundry Plus in Madison for six years. After his retirement from Heritage Homes, he drove a truck for various companies. He was a member of the American Legion Post 35 in Madison. He served in the U.S. Army Sept. 2, 1958, through April 10, 1963, during the Cuban missile crisis.
